Bob Morgan has a B.S. in Civil Engineering from the University of Utah. He is also a Registered Professional Engineer.

January 3, 2002 - Present

Executive Director for the Utah Department of Natural Resources. Appointed by the Governor. Bob is a member of the Governor's Cabinet and is administrative leader of a state agency with more than 1,200 employees and a budget of approximately \$83 million. Mr. Morgan manages seven divisions: 1) Forestry, Fire and State Lands, 2) Oil, Gas and Mining, 3) Parks and Recreation, 4) Utah Geological Survey, 5) Water Rights, 6) Water Resources and 7) Wildlife Resources. He also manages the department's administrative office, including the Center for Policy and Planning and the Utah Energy Office, and is responsible for coordination and cooperation among these divisions and offices.

1985 - 2002

State Engineer for the state of Utah. Appointed by the Governor. Responsible for the administration, appropriation, adjudication and distribution of the waters of the state. Also responsible for dam safety, stream alterations and water well drillers.

1977 - 1985

Assistant State Engineer for Dam Safety, Division of Water Rights. Managed the National Dam Safety Program. State representative for the draining of Thistle Lake in April 1983.

1974 - 1977

Regional Engineer, Division of Water Rights. Responsible for the regional office dealing with the Sevier River drainage.

1970 - 1974

Division of Water Resources, state of Utah. Hydrologic engineer in planning, design and construction.
