Abstract

The Department of Planning and Natural Resources (DPNR) administers the Territorial Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Program through the Division of Environmental Protection, Water Pollution Control Program to evaluate, monitor and permit industrial and municipal facilities throughout the Territory.

The Water Pollution Control Program further ensures that discharges to the waters of the USVI meet the requirements established by the CWA and the Territorial Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permitting Program.
