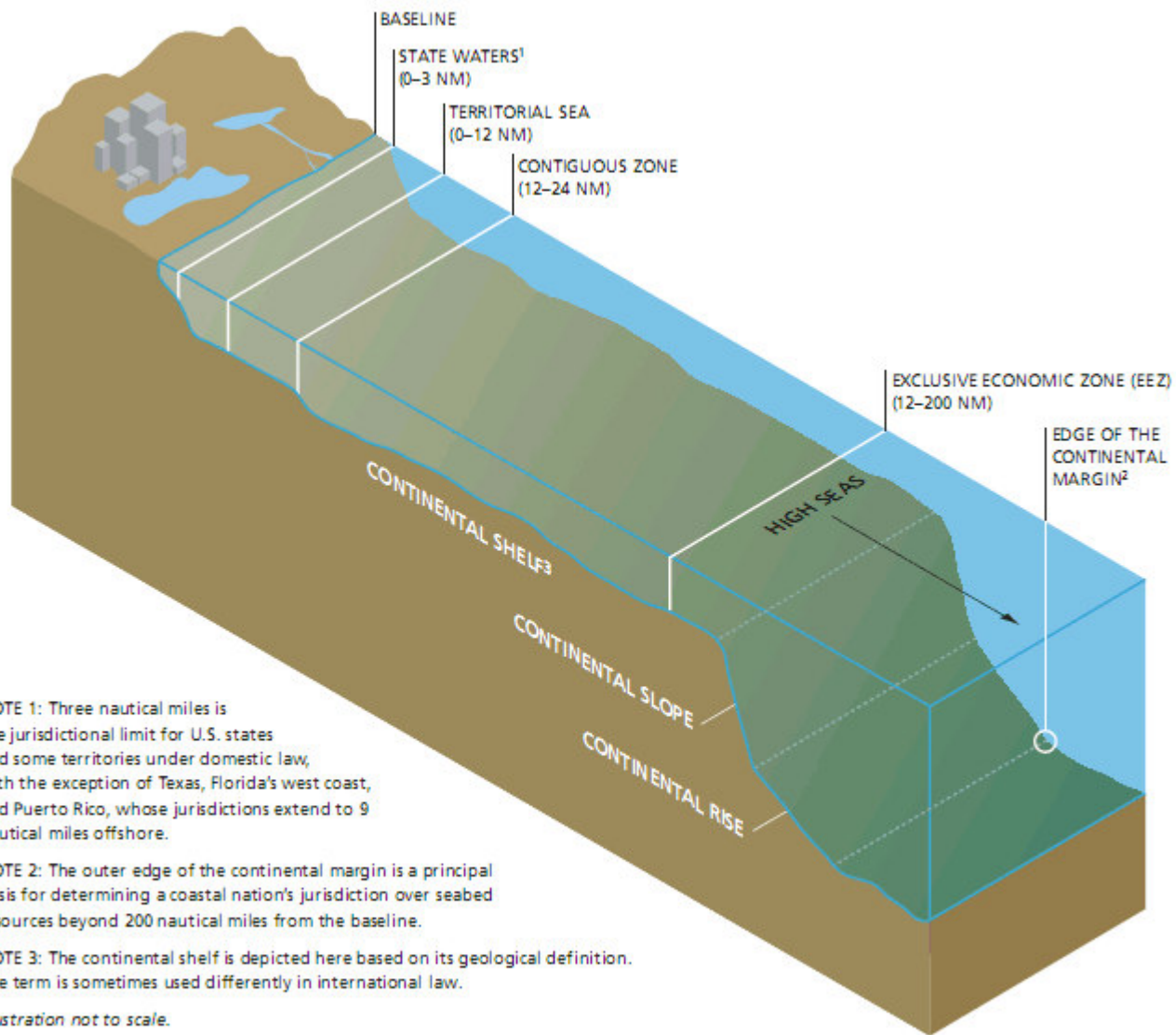


Figure P.1 Lines of U.S. Authority in Offshore Waters
